# Android Based App "Baldia Shikayaat" Launched to Improve Municipal Service Delivery In All 16 PCP Partner Cities





Under Punjab Cities Program (PCP) various development initiatives regarding infrastructure sub projects, capacity building and certain E-governance initiatives have been introduced for institutional strengthening of 16 PCP partner MCs. upgradation of already introduced systems i.e. Performance Management System (PMS), transforming Complaint Tracking System (CTS) into Grievance Redressal management and transforming MC's static website into dynamic ones was needed to meet contemporary challenges and to improve the municipal service delivery landscape in PCP cities. These systems are of significant nature for MCs in identification of problem areas, provide monitoring and tracking the progress of municipal service delivery, provide information to MC management and support budget requests and decision making in improved service delivery.

Furthering these efforts PCP team introduced an android based application "Baldia Shikayaat" aimed to provide an efficient complaint redress solution and to create a database of the citizens' grievances redressal for effective monitoring. Citizens can download the app from Google play store h t t p s://play.google.com/store/https://play.google.com/store/https://play.google.com/store/https://paps/details?id=baldiashikayaat.pmdfc.org.pk and can launch their complaint in few steps, which will be immediately received by the relevant MC staff for its resolution. PCP, IS Team also worked to develop dynamic websites of all 16 partner MCs for better information dissemination amongst stakeholders and this will also contribute in "Transparency & Accountability" an important PCP DLI Result Area.

Training sessions were arranged at regional levels, i.e Gujranwala, Faisalabad, Multan on 16,17 and 18 August, respectively, to apprise relevant Municipal Committee's Staff about the new/upgraded IT based systems. These systems are important for MCs in identification of problem areas, they provide monitoring and tracking of the progress of Municipal Service delivery and provide information to MC management. At regional level 16 MC staff (Chief Officers, Municipal Officers (Infrastructure and Services), Municipal Officers (Planning), Sub-Engineers, Complaint Cell In-charge and other municipal services staff were trained on the upgraded systems.
