News In Brief/Visits

World Bank Visits to PMDFC

- World Bank team comprising Ms. Shehnaz Arshad (Senior Urban Specialist-PMSIP Team Leader) and Mr. Raja Rehan Arshad (Lead Operation Officer) visited PMDFC on December 14, 2011. Progress towards agreed actions was reviewed. Future role of PMDFC particularly in the context of sustainability of different ID interventions being introduced under PMSIP was also discussed.

 Keven Taylor visited PMDFC on
 November 19, 2011 to conduct a
 meeting with Planning Section PMDFC. Matters pertaining to
 updation of Planning Maps of phase –
 ITMAs by PMDFC and monitoring of
 the tasks performed by consulting
 firms i.e. M/S EPMC-SAGE (JV) and
 M/S Osmani & Co. Methodology,
 achievements and future course of
 actions were also discussed in detail.

Delivery of Equipments to TMAs

PMDFC provided the following equipments to its partner TMAs (Phase-II):

- 159 Computers & 178 Printers with UPS for general office use to (60) TMAs
- 24 Computers with Printers & UPS for implementation of Computerized Financial Management System (CFMS) to (12) TMAs

Detailed Refresher Training Workshops to Implement ID Interventions

The detailed refresher training sessions were organized to facilitate TMA staff in adoption of ID interventions of the project. In this regard, 09 training workshops on Performance Management System (PMS) and 03 training workshops on Complaint Tracking System (CTS) were arranged in the month of December 2011. Core objectives of the trainings were as under:

- Sensitization, motivation and mobilization of TMA staff for adoption of PMS and CTS
- Creation of sense of ownership and responsibility helping in creation of self sustainable culture of regular information collection, maintenance and reporting for better decision making/service delivery
- Awareness about their role and other stakeholder's role in establishing PMS and CTS
- Removing gaps in understanding and implementation
- Benefits of adoption of PMS and CTS for TMA and for themselves
- · Importance of data collection, updation and reporting

Follow Up Visits of Institutional Development - Interventions in Partner TMAs by PMDFC ID Team

PMDFC Institutional Development (ID) teams visited 86 partners TMAs to facilitate the TMA staff in adoption of ID interventions. Hands-on trainings to TMA staff were provided primarily on data collection, data maintenance, updation and data reporting; following SOPs for different ID interventions including PMS, CTS and TMA website. Issues in slow adoption of ID interventions were discussed with TMA leadership and they were mobilized for taking appropriate actions in this regard.

Provision of Computer Training

Computer Training has been successfully completed in 44 TMAs out of 68 TMAs so far and 505 trainees attended this PMDFC facilitated Computer Training Program.

Visits of Planning Team

Teams consisting of staff of Planning Section - PMDFC visited 38 partners TMA. Tasks performed during these visits included the updation / verification of planning reports and GIS maps to fill out the missing gaps of data. They also held meetings with concerned TMOs and data was updated with the assistance of TMA staff. The remaining partner TMAs will be visited in January 2012.

Procurement & Environment Pre-Bid Meeting & Bid Opening

Procurement & Evaluation Section of PMDFC held a pre-bid meeting with prospective bidders and briefed them about various aspects of bid preparation and their submission to concerned authorities. The salient features of the forthcoming sub-project were also explained to them in details. The underlying objectives of the Pre-bid meeting were to promote healthy competition amongst bidders, minimize bid rejection due to minor technical mistakes and ensure transparency.
